The Educational Reform Proposal and How It Supports Growing UNESCO Influences in Idaho Schools

**Prepared for the Idaho Legislature by F. Willard Robinson, Ed.D.
(Substantiating documents available: 331-5044)**

- The Governor and the Idaho Board of Education have entered into an agreement with the Gates Foundation and the U.S. Department of Education which threatens state control. This is because Bill Gates operates under a Cooperation Agreement with UNESCO. This agreement gives UNESCO control over “teacher training, curriculum, and assessments, all to meet the goals of UNESCO in every country and community in the world.”
- The State Board of Education, under the leadership of Rod Lewis, a Micron Executive, and Governor Kempthorne in September, 2005, presented a plan to strengthen mathematics and science programs. Not so well advertised is that the plan incorporates the UNESCO sponsored International Baccalaureate Program, which is included as an elective course of study in the Idaho State Board’s Education Reform proposal.
- Essential to the **International Baccalaureate Program** (hereafter referred to as IB) is “attitude, value and behavioral objectives.” In review of the contents of the IB it is clear that the curriculum promotes values that are in conflict with the founding values of the United States. The targets of IB social-political reengineering are high-achieving students, identified by an applicant screening process. Despite conflicts with American ideals, the State Board of Education will be seeking taxpayer’s funds to help defray the costs of IB.
- The U.S. Department of Education, the National Governor’s Association and the Commission of the States are the vehicles through which the Educational Reform Program is promoted. It is a part and parcel of the “New Federalism” plan. The Governor and members of the State Board of Education belong to the Education Commission of the States. The membership fee, paid by the State of Idaho, is \$53,800 a year.
- Most distressing is IB demands that all participating student records be sent to Europe for grading and evaluation. These personal records then “become the absolute property of IB and UNESCO.
- Other politically biased international programs, sponsored by UNESCO operating in public, charter and private schools in the State of Idaho include Globe Education, Civic Education and Human Rights Education. Although there are some valued aspects to these programs the overall influence is not positive.

- "...hand first slid down her neck to her breasts and then explored her entire body. ...P. took her hand in his and invited her to explore his body... touched the hard muscles on P.'s arms and chest; lower down, she felt a red-hot coal that throbbled through his clothes."
- "...stripped of her clothed, got into the shower.. felt her nipples grow hard as stone... water ran down her back and curved like a waterfall over the round thrust of her buttocks.... ... what did she see on the other side of the planks but [him] watching her intently."
- "...went to her, [put out] lamp, pulled her to a.. bed.. throwing himself upon her, caused her to lose her virginity and learn of true love."
- "...he took on the job of going to every single brothel and gaining the confidence of every single prostitute.... recited verses and poems while making love to them.... all ready to work for the revolution... with the help of his friends the whores... he killed the traitor, by beating him to death. When there was no more life left.. T. cut off his testicles with a knife... [said it] was an act of revenge.. man.. had raped his mother and his sister."

Prince William County Public Schools required reading for 10th grade IB English

- Page 1: "Nuns go by as quiet as lust. ... R. ...sits in a [car] eating bread and butter... When she comes out of the car we will beat her up, make red marks on her white skin, and she will cry and ask us if we want to pull her pants. We will say no. We don't know what we should feel or do if she does, but whenever she asks us, we know she is offering us something precious and that our own pride must be asserted by refusing to accept."
- "... mother comes.. she rubs the Vicks salve on my chest until I am faint... puts it in my mouth, telling me to swallow... later I throw up... What did you puke.. for? Don't you have sense... think I got time for nothing but washing up your puke? The puke swaddles down the pillow onto the sheet-green-gray, with flecks of orange. It moves like the inside of an uncooked egg... clinging to its own mass... mother drones on.. talking to the puke, but she is calling it my name.."
- "...threw [water] in C's face. ..naked and ashen, he leapt from the bed, and with a flying tackle, grabbed his wife around the waist and they hit the floor.. picked her up and knocked her down with the back of his hand. ...struck her several times in the face. . . hit his hand against the metal bed frame when his wife ducked... S. ...began to hit his father about the head with both fists, shouting "You naked fuck!" over and over... S. screamed Kill him! Kill him!"
- "White kids; his mother [told him] did not like to play with niggers. ..difference between colored people and niggers... easily identifiable... Colored people were neat and quiet; niggers were dirty and loud. Even though he was light-skinned ..line.. was not always clear.. watch had to be constant. [he] used to long to play with the black boys. ..wanted to feel their hardness pressing on him, smell their wild blackness, and say 'Fuck you' with that lovely casualness. ..In the toilet he wanted to share with them the laurels of being able to pee far and long. ...More and more [he] enjoyed bullying girls. It was easy to make them scream and run. How he laughed... The nigger girls he did not pick on very much. They usually traveled in packs..."
- Rape of his daughter: "...staggered home reeling drunk and saw his daughter in the kitchen.. Why did she have to look so whipped?.. her misery was an accusation. He wanted to break her neck - but tenderly. Guilt and impotence rose.. What could a burned-out black man say to the hunched back of his 11 year old daughter... hatred of her slimed in his stomach and threatened to become vomit. But just before the puke moved... she.. stood on one foot scratching the back of her calf with her toe.... filled him with a wondering softness. Not the usual lust to part tight legs with his own... desire to cover her foot with his hand and gently nibble away the calf with his teeth. He did it...sank to his knees.. Crawling on all fours toward her.. nibbled at the back of her leg. His mouth trembled at the firm sweetness of the flesh... closed his eyes, letting his fingers dig into her waist.. rigidness of her shocked body... better than P.'s easy laughter had been.. doing of a wild and forbidden thing excited him.. bolt of desire ran down his genitals, giving it length, and softening the lips of his anus.. wanted to fuck her - tenderly. But the tenderness would not hold.. tightness of her vagina was more than he could bear.. gigantic thrust he made into her then provoked the only sound she made - a hollow suck of air in the back of her throat... Removing himself from her was do painful to him he cut it short and snatched his genitals out of the dry harbor of her vagina. She appeared to have fainted. C. ..could see only her grayish panties, so limp and so sad

around her ankles.. hatred mixed with tenderness.. hatred would not let him pick her up, the tenderness forced him to cover her. ..regained consciousness.. on floor.. [she] was trying to connect the pain between her legs with the face of her mother looming over her.”

The Color Purple

- Book is a series of letters written to God or her sister about the events of the main character's (Celie) life. Language includes: Goddamn, bitch, shit, nigger, and fuck.
- Controversial material starts on page 1: "I am 14 years old... [after the baby was born her dad] was pulling on her [mom's] arm. She say it too soon.. I ain't well.. A week go by, he pulling on her arm again. She say Naw, I ain't gonna.. she went to visit her sister.. [her dad] say You gonna do what your mammy wouldn't. First he put his thing up against my hip and sort of wiggle it around. Then he grab hold my titties. then he push his thing inside my pussy. when that hurt, I cry. he start to choke me, saying You better shut up and git used to it. But i don't ever git used to it. And now I feels sick every time I be the one to cook."
- "My mamma dead. She died screaming and cussing. She scream at me. She cuss at me. I'm big.... She ast me about the first one Whose is it? I say God's.. my stomach start moving and then that little baby come out my pussy chewing on it fist.. She ast Where is it? I say God took it. He [her dad] took it while I was sleeping. Kilt it out there in the woods. Kill this one too, if he can."
- "He come home with a girl.. She be my age but they married. He be on her all the time."
- "I ast him to take me instead of N.[my sister] while our new mammy sick.. I tell him I can fix myself up for him.. come out wearing horsehair, feathers and a pair of.. high heel shoes. He beat me for dressing trampy but he do it to me anyway."

The Handmaid's Tale

- Story set in future where psychotic theocracy controls every aspect of everyone's life
- "Stillborn, it was. Or, Stabbed her with a knitting needle, right in the belly. ..Or.. It was toilet cleaner she used."
- "...I know they're watching, these 2 men who aren't yet permitted to touch women. They touch with their eyes instead... I move my hips a little... like.. teasing a dog with a bone held out of reach.. I enjoy the power... I hope they get hard at the sight of us and have to rub themselves.. They will suffer.. at night, in their.. beds ... no outlets now except themselves, and that's a sacrilege.. no more magazines, no more films.."
- "It's J., telling bout how she was gang-raped at 14 and had an abortion.. told same story last week... seemed almost proud of it.. whose fault was it? Aunt H. says.. Her fault, her fault, her fault, we chant.. Who led them on? She did. She did. She did. Why did God allow such a terrible thing... Teach her a lesson. Teach her a lesson. Teach her a lesson."
- Young woman slaves to make babies for older couples: "...towards the head of the bed S. is arranged, outspread.. legs are apart, I lie between them.. head on her stomach, her pubic bone under the base of my skull, her thighs on either side of me. She too is fully clothed.. My.. skirt is hitched up to my waist. Below it the Commander is fucking.. fucking the lower part of my body.. not making love.. [not] copulating.. because it would imply 2 people and only 1 is involved.. wasn't a lot of choice, but there was some, and this is what I chose... I wish he would hurry up... S. grips my hands as if it is she, not I, who's being fucked.. [he] fucks with a regular 2-4 marching stroke, on and on like a tap dripping. He is preoccupied.. somewhere else.. an impatience in his rhythm now.. isn't this everyone's wet dream, 2 women at once? They used to say that. exciting, they used to say... nothing to do with sexual desire, at least for me, and certainly not for S. Arousal and orgasm are no longer thought necessary.. his not-unpleasant face hanging over my torso... If he were better looking would I enjoy this more?... an improvement on the previous [man], who smelled like a church cloakroom in the rain, like your mouth when the dentist starts picking at your teeth.. Kissing is forbidden between us. This makes it bearable... He comes at last, with a stifled groan of relief... rests a moment, withdraws, recedes, rezippers.. nods, then turns and leaves the room.."
- "Sometimes.. movie [Aunt L.] showed would be an old porno film, from the 70's or 80's. Women kneeling, sucking penises or guns, woman tied up or chained or with dog collars around their necks.. hanging from trees.. upside-down, naked,..legs held part, woman being raped, beaten up, killed. Once.. woman slowly cut into pieces, fingers and breasts snipped off with garden shears, her stomach slit open and her intestines pulled out."

- "The Commander and I have an arrangement.. I visit [him] 2 or 3 nights week, always after dinner.. The difficulty is the Wife as always.. What had I been expecting.. the first time. Something unspeakable, down on all fours perhaps, perversions, whips, mutilations? At.. very least some minor sexual manipulation.. prohibited by law and punishable by amputation."
- "Are you calling L. a social disease?.. M. laughed.. Shit.... was a time when we didn't hug, after she'd told me about her being gay; but then she said I didn't turn her on.."
- "My God. Who Art in the Kingdom of Heaven... I think about the chandelier too much.. you could use a hook in the closet... after attaching yourself.. lean your weight forward and not fight.. I feel very unreal, talking to You like this. I feel as if I'm talking to a wall. I wish You'd answer. I feel so alone... Oh God... Oh God oh God. How can I keep on living?"
- "What the hell are you doing here? M. says.. What'd you do wrong? Laugh at his dick?... The shit you're with.. I've had him, he's the pits.. He's my Commander I say. She nods. Some of them do that, they get a kick out of it.. like screwing on the alter.. your gang are supposed to be such chaste vessels. They like to see you painted up."
- "...supposed to demoralize the men, having to wear a dress. Shit, it would demoralize me.. shit, nobody but a nun would pick the colonies.. So here I am.. even give you face cream. You should.. [get] in here... have 3 or 4 good years before your snatch wears out and they send you to the boneyard.. there's drink and drugs... and we only work nights... lots of women around. Butch paradise.. hell, they encourage it.. we're all damned anyway.. doesn't matter what sort of vice we get up to.. don't give a piss what we do in our off time.. women on women sort of turns them on."
- "Your time's [to become pregnant] running out [the Commander's wife] says.... Maybe he can't she says... Maybe you should try it another way. Does she mean on all fours? Another man she says.... It's a risk I say.. Maybe I could get something... you want [she says].. A picture.. Of her.. Your little girl... The bitch not to tell [where they've put her]"
- "Will S. talk about me like that, if I do as she wants: Agreed to do it right away, really she didn't care, anything with 2 legs and a good you-know-what was fine with her."
- "Camaraderie, shit says M.... right fucking on, Aunt L., as they used to say. .. bet she's got Janine down on her knees.. What do you think they get up to in that office.. bet she's got her working away on that dried-up old withered--.. something powerful in the whispering of obscenities, about those in power.. delightful.. naughty, secretive, forbidden, thrilling.. someone.. had scratched [on bathroom stall wall] Aunt L. sucks.. So now I imagine, among these Angels and their drained white brides, momentous grunts and sweating, damp furry encounters.. better... failures, cocks like 3 week old carrots.."
- "There are a great many buttocks in this room. I am no longer used to them... He is showing me off.. they are decorous enough, they keep their hands to themselves, but they review my breasts, my legs... Nature demands variety for men [he says].. procreational strategy.. Nature's plan.. Women know that instinctively ... buy so many different cloths, in the old days.. To trick the man into thinking they were with several different women. A new one each day."
- "The first [checkpoint] scared the shit out of me."
- "...that Aunts way like a goddamn soldier, poker up the ass.."
- "...nearly shat bricks the whole time... They had silent prayers every evening.. reminded me too much of that shit at the Center... ever thought what it would be like to be shat on by a truckload of chickens, all of them carsick... She pretended to do all that love-the-sinner, hate-the-sin stuff, but she enjoyed it [steel cable torture].. I did consider offing myself, and maybe I would have if there'd been any way."
