On behalf of the Bow Parent-Teacher Organization membership, I would like to invite you to attend a *Meet the Candidates* forum at the Old Town Hall on Bow Center Road on March 3, 2010 from 7:00pm to 9:00pm. This forum will provide our community with an opportunity to meet candidates for our local offices here in Bow, and to learn more about the issues surrounding the election.

During the forum, candidates will be given the opportunity to speak for four minutes each, introducing themselves, giving background information, and explaining why they are seeking office in the upcoming election. Question cards will be distributed to the audience as they enter the meeting, and all may turn in candidate questions to the moderator for consideration. After all candidates have spoken, the selected questions from the audience will be asked by the moderator, and candidates will be allowed a one minute response to each relevant question. This will not be a debate and candidates will not be allowed to address each other. The forum is closed to any other questions from the audience and media once the questions have been chosen by the moderator.

You may bring signs, posters and/or other campaign materials with you to the forum. There will be a designated area/table where they will be displayed or available for pick up by attendees.

I have invited all candidates seeking election in the offices of Selectmen, Budget Committee, Library Trustee, and School Board. The membership chose not to invite candidates running for offices that will be unopposed. I will also be inviting reporters from the Union Leader and the Concord Monitor. I'm hoping for a great turnout, and look forward to including you in the agenda.
